### **AREA #1**

**\*We participate in Farm to School activities and/or have a school garden.** (To be researched by Child Nutrition and pursued if correct choice for our District. Also, research "locally grown" products.)

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #1**

Child Nutrition - Participating in potential food buying cooperative for the 18-19 SY of Farm to School products to include local fruits, vegetables and beef. Also, Child Nutrition will "market" and provide educational opportunities when these products become available. (ie. Signage indicating locally grown items, Meet your Farmer/Rancher events during lunch periods, taste testings of locally grown items)

Elementary Administrator/Board Member – Science/STEM/garden centers to be implemented during the 18-19SY

#### **2019 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #1**

Child Nutrition - Participating in food buying cooperative for the 19-20 SY of Farm to School products to include local fruits and vegetables. Also, Child Nutrition will "market" and provide educational opportunities when these products become available.

- Menu and Signage indicating locally grown items
- Taste testings of locally grown items

Additionally, Child Nutrition requires produce vendor to provide state/local/regional products when available and indicate where all products are grown.

District - Intermediate Administrator/Board Member – Hydroponic garden area built for Science/STEM/garden centers to be implemented during the 19-20SY

### **AREA #2**

**\*We prohibit the use of food and beverages as a reward.** (We encourage faculty not to use food and beverages as a reward.)

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #2**

Child Nutrition - will provide faculty with alternate rewards for students periodically via email.

Administrators – have continued to encourage staff to use alternate rewards and additionally reward staff with alternate rewards such as "Jeans Passes".

#### **2019 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #2**

Child Nutrition - Monthly newsletters suggesting healthy alternatives and periodic emails will provide faculty with alternate rewards for students.

Administrators – have continued to encourage staff to use alternate rewards and additionally reward staff with alternate rewards such as "Jeans Passes".

### **AREA #3**

**\*We operate an Afterschool Snack Program.** (To be researched by Child Nutrition and pursued if correct choice for our District).

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #3**

Child Nutrition – at this time we have been advised this program would not be the correct choice for GPS per OKSDE-CN but we remain open to assisting after school activities and will research upon request.

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#### **AREA #4**

**\*We require physical education classes for graduation (high schools only).** (To be discussed with HS Administrator)

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #4**

Due to curriculum requirements and facilities/staff shortages we strongly encourage physical education but do not require physical education for graduation.

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#### **AREA #5**

**\*We prohibit staff and teachers from keeping kids in from recess for punitive reasons.** (We encourage faculty not to keep students from recess for punitive reasons; to be discussed with Elementary Administrators to suggest optional lunch detention "laps" and/or conditioning)

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #5**

Elementary students are allowed to participate in physical activity each day; even during discipline times they walk laps or participate in physical conditioning.

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#### **AREA #6**

**\*We provide annual training to all staff on Nutrition and Physical Activity** (To be discussed with Director of Curriculum to suggest to add to annual staff training)

#### **2018 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #6**

Implement Nutrition and Physical Activity Training into 18-19 SY annual Staff Training.  
Child Nutrition – Provide staff with menu designed to support high levels of nutrition  
Possibly invite local community gym/nutrition store to hand out memberships/coupons during back to school event for staff.

#### **2019 Assessment/Improvements of AREA #6**

Implement Nutrition and Physical Activity Training into 19-20 SY annual Staff Training.  
Child Nutrition – Provide staff with menu designed to support high levels of nutrition  
Local community gym/nutrition store participated in 19-20SY back to school event and to handed out memberships/coupons/merchandise.
